



## **JOB DEFINITION FOR DALLAS WEEKDAY SCHOOL OF THE BIBLE VOLUNTEERS**

### **I. GENERAL**

3. The VOLUNTEER is contracted by the Director following the recommendation of the DWSB Administrator upon completion of an application and background check.

Volunteer is defined as:

1. A Christian who holds to the Statement of Faith of the Dallas Weekday School of the Bible.
2. One who feels called of God to be a help in sharing His Word and example with children.
3. One who is spiritually mature with academic and leadership abilities that will allow him/her to impart God's truth in a faithful and responsible manner.

### **II. SPIRITUAL STANDARDS**

A volunteer's primary role in the school is to exemplify Christ by:

1. Portraying the mind of Christ.
2. Seeking fellowship with fellow believers.
3. Being faithful in prayer and the reading of God's Word.
4. Abstaining from sexual immorality or any conduct contrary to the lifestyle of the faithful in Christ as defined in scripture.
5. Encouraging students by example and word.
6. Membership in a church, represented by regular church attendance.
7. One who represents themselves with modesty and reflects semi professional attire.
8. Maintain confidences and accept responsibility as a team player to the teacher.
9. Assume responsibility for materials and equipment. Use materials economically and cultivate respect for school property and students.
